The Tasmanian Government, in partnership with Tasmanian NRM regional bodies, has announced the \$2 million Agricultural Landscape Rehabilitation Scheme (ALRS) to assist flood-affected landowners and communities through funding projects aimed at rehabilitation of land and stream systems damaged as a result of the June 2016 floods.

The focus of the program is to restore the capacity of the primary production sector and reduce impacts of future floods on productive land.

The scheme is open to landowners and communities in the twenty local government areas affected by the June 2016 flood.
